The service is available to anyone who would like to learn how to apply products to cover scarring or a skin condition. Skin camouflage is suitable for men, women and children over five, of all ethnicities.

How do I get access to the camouflage service?

Changing Faces Channel Islands requires that you visit your GP or practice nurse and be referred to the skin camouflage service.

Once your GP or practice nurse has approved that the camouflage service is suitable for you, the skin camouflage team will contact you to make an appointment.

Changing Faces Channel Islands has agreed that for referred cases they will cover the cost of the skin camouflage appointment with our qualified skin practitioners.

They may also cover the cost of the GP or practice nurse referral for those paying for these costs themselves. Further information can be provided by the practitioner at your skin camouflage appointment or by visiting our website at www.changingfacesci.org.gg

What is the Skin Camouflage Service?

For someone living with scarring or a skin condition that affects their confidence, specialist camouflage products can offer a way to cope. Our service helps people to gain self-confidence and independence.

The products provide effective waterproof cover and can reduce the appearance of a number of skin conditions, including:

Scarring from burns, acne and self-harm etc

Vitiligo

Rosacea

Melasma

Birthmarks

Leg veins

Hyper-pigmentation

Local charity Changing Faces Channel Islands works with the UK charity Changing Faces to support and provide services for people with facial differences and disfigurements. Our skin camouflage practitioners have been trained by Changing Faces in the UK and are fully qualified to provide this service.

At your appointment our skin camouflage practitioners will select the best colour match for your skin tone and will then show you how to apply the specialist products yourself to improve the appearance of affected areas.
